		Icons and priority colors have been added and/or updated.

For example, in a single Panel, there items may appear as 50 low, 12 medium, 2 high, and 1 critical (i.e. because the color red indicates a critical item, and Critical is the highest priority status, the corresponding Panel appears with an underling of red). 	
		 When a user hovers over a Process Panel count, a tooltip appears to show the counts by priority. 	
		 A user can click on a Process Panel count icon (♠ 1, ♥ 0, ▼ 0) to display the corresponding tab (i.e., Active, Suspended, Waiting items). 	
		 Process Panels are now sortable, via drag and drop functionality: hovering over the "drag handle" (!!) a tooltip appears and (in most browsers) the cursor changes to a "grab" or "move" () cursor.

Adv Queue▶ Toolbar (Action Buttons)		 Action buttons and work item list are hidden during list refresh. Action buttons are disabled by default. However, these buttons are enabled when at least one row in the list is selected.
Adv Queue► Work Item List		 "Lazy loading" was implemented to make it possible for Work Item Lists to be loaded only when the user requests that data: improving load time and preventing "drag" on the server. When a Waiting or Suspended Work Item is released, the active Work Item list automatically refreshes the next time a user accesses it. In addition, when releasing a Waiting Work Item, a progress indicator is displayed to confirm that work is being processed. The AQ Search and Show & Hide Processes features are disabled whenever the Work Queue (i.e., Work Items) is loading. Not hidden just disabled When the AQ Work Item list is empty, the action buttons (i.e., Search, and Show & Hide Processes) are disabled, and "No work-items available" message appears. Waiting exit path drop-down was updated to display a long dash instead of the value of "None". The columns hidden by default, are also now hidden from the Work Item List column section. However, they can be displayed if the user clicks on the column section (within the column menu) 5 times within one second.
		 NOTES Columns that are set as hidden by default are those that are generally used by TPOCS and DocuPhase staff to troubleshoot issues, The default column settings are saved to the browser; therefore, they are reset when cache is cleared. Hidden columns are Work Item List-specific, therefore, they must be set for each list. To optimize system processing, Work Item List sizes are now static, and set to 10, 15, & 20. (i.e., no longer user configurable/read from the config file). In previous versions, users were able to set the number of items per list to such large numbers that system processes would
		freeze. In most browsers, the cursor is changed to a "Wait" indicator while a list is being rendered.
Dynamic Document Security (DDS)	32904	The TPOC or DocuPhase PS can now assign a document for editing by particular users only. Unlike Document Level Security, DDS is set in the system (behind the UI), and has a more global intent, rather than being attached to specific Indexes.

		• A Request for New Account link can be added to the Sign In screen. When the link is displayed, a new user who should (but doesn't) have access to the system, can use it to display a dialog window into which they can enter basic information. That information is then submitted to the System Administrator who can then verify information, and configure the new user account.

Known Issues in this Release

Appendix - Workaround for SSO Windows Authentication

When setting up DocuPhase to use SSO, the DocuPhase site is *only using Windows Authentication* (see <u>Item 29923</u> on page 13 of this document).

Anonymous and Forms authentications are disabled: preventing DocuPhase Service from calling on the subdirectory DocuPhase/Web/Services: causing a 401 error.

! IMPORTANT!

The procedure described below is only necessary AFTER enabling SSO using the DocuPhase SSO Configuration Guide found at the following location:

The workaround for this issue is to configuring the DocuPhase server IIS app pool to accept the DocuPhase windows service login attempts for HTML5 cache clearing, as shown below.

Under the DocuPhase Server name in IIS Manager:

Go to Sites Default Web
 Site DocuPhase Web
 Services.

In the Services window:

- Make sure that the Anonymous Authentication is Enabled, but all other Authentication settings are Disabled (as shown in image).
